



Bollington Neighbourhood Pledge



Some of you will be aware that Cheshire Police were looking for a male in the Bollington area at teatime [on Sunday]. We would like to provide you with some further details about the incident and reassure you that it was treated as a priority by your local officers.

At 6.30pm on Sunday the 26th July 2009 Cheshire Police were made aware that a 26 year old patient from Hollins Park Mental Health Hospital, Winwick, Warrington, had been reported missing by hospital staff.

Concern was raised due to the patient's mental health issues and an immediate and extensive search was carried out by Police in Warrington and in areas of Macclesfield.

Procedures were quickly put into place at a local level in order to ensure that the safety of the public was a priority and to facilitate the return of the patient to the hospital.

The patient now remains in Hollins Park Mental Health Hospital in a secure environment.

It is important to us that you feel the actions taken and the information we have provided has made a positive difference to you and your family.
